


Environmental Monitoring



Environmental monitoring (regularly testing wastewater, indoor air, and certain surfaces) for the presence of the virus that causes COVID-19 serves as a double-check to ensure that everyday protocols (e.g. face coverings, physical distancing) are working, and as an early warning system to preempt spread.


WASTEWATER MONITORING WITHIN THE CITY

Wastewater testing monitors for the presence of the virus that causes COVID-19 to identify infection trends across the city, and act as an early warning system to identify if any new variants are present.



AIR FILTER AND SURFACE TESTING IN SCHOOLS

Air filter and surface sampling monitor if the virus has been present in a building or room.
